## NORTHERN BLUEGRASS USBC ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 United States Bowling congress rules and regulations will govern this tournament. All prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis.
- 2 The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust any bowlers average prior to the time the bowler participates. Any adjustments will be done according to rule 319c.
- 3 Rules 319 d and 319e will be waived in this tournament.
- 4 Handicap will be based on 90% of 660.
- Individuals may bowl more than once in the singles event but are eligible to place in the prize fund only once. Individuals may bowl more than once in the doubles event but must change partners to place more than once in the prize fund. Individuals may bowl more than once in the team event under conditions outlined in Rule 315. Any five (5) members of the N.B. USBC Association may form a team. Not more than three players on any team may place more than once in the prize list for position standings. Bowlers participating in all events must use the <a href="FIRST SCORE">FIRST SCORE</a> in any event. Seniors age 50 and up (age as of August 1 of current bowling year) may also participate in the seniors handicap all events division for an additional \$5.00 entry fee.
- Sa Re-entry. After entries have closed a team will have the option to re-enter the tournament using the exact same team members. (No substitutions), and dependent upon the availability of lanes. The team will be allowed unlimited re-entry but will be allowed to cash only once. Doubles will have the option to re-enter the tournamentusing the exact same team members, (no substitutions), and dependent upon the availability of lanes. The doubles team will be allowed unlimited re-entry but will be allowed to cash only once. Singles will have the option to re-enter the tournament dependent upon the availability of lanes. Singles will be allowed unlimited re-entry but will be allowed to cash only once. All re-entries will be dependent upon lane availability.
- 6 Lineups for teams and doubles must be submitted in order on the entry form. Corrections will be made in case of emergency or substitutions. No pacers permitted. If ineligible bowler bowls on any team, no prize money will be awarded to team or individual, or refund of entries made. Team captains are responsible for eligibility and averages of team members. Doubles or singles only will be permitted. All entries received must be accompanied by full payment. Tournament prize money will be distributred at a place and time to be determined later. Winners notified in advance.
- 7 Team captains must report in to tournament manager 30 minutes prior to scheduled starting time to report substitutions, present USBC cards, and be assigned lanes.
- 8 Bowlers must be ready to bowl at assigned times. No shift will be held for tardy bowlers. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame being bowled with a zero for each frame missed. Teams or individuals missing their scheduled shift times will be placed in another shift if possible and if tournament director is notified before scheduled shift time. If not, there will be no refunds.
- 9 Ties for first place will be decided by a roll off after the tournament. Other ties will be handled by the tournament director in accordance with Rule 326a.
- 10 The failure to use proper verification of average or make corrections prior to the completion of the first game bowled shall be a disqualified score. If disqualified score is lower to receive more handicap, the bowlers score is disqualified. If the average is higher than submitted, prize winnings will be based on submitted average per rule 319a.
- 11 In case of protest, call tournament manager or official on duty at once or state in writing before prize money is awarded. Rule 329
- 12 All entries must be accompanied by full payment.
- 13 Provisional ball will be used in a situation where a rule cannot be resolved immediately. Rule 10.
- 14 Entries will be open to all members of the Northern Bluegrass USBC Association and to members of other associations who bowl in leagues certified through Northern Bluegrass Association and have a NBUSBCA membership. Bowlers must be a current member of Northern Bluegrass Association, with 21 games in current year or have a certified yearbook average from year prior.
- 15 Bowlers will use highest 2019-2020 yearbook average. If no yearbook average, bowler will use highest NBUSBCA league average as of 12/31/20. (minimum of 21 games.) Rule 319c will apply if average is 10 pins higher.
- 16 "Walk In" entries will be accepted after tournament starts dependent on availability of lanes. Walk in entries or re-entries will be received at least 1/2 hour before shift starts.
- 17 Singles / Doubles format will have singles bowled first and then doubles.
- 18 All returned checks will have a \$25.00 service charge. Any check not "taken care of" will be turned over to the authorities.
- 19 Lanes are to be dressed after each shift.
